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Opportunity for an under 18-year-old child/dependant to join the Register.

Anthony Nolan takes back lives from leukaemia by providing lifesaving donors for patients in need of a stem cell transplant. Since 1974 we have helped to give almost 6,000 children and adults a new chance of life.

A transplant of bone marrow or blood stem cells is used to offer hope to patients with leukaemia or other potentially fatal blood related illnesses. Ongoing work is being done to investigate the possibility of using blood stem cells to treat numerous other medical conditions. We work to offer patients in the UK and around the world a better chance of a successful bone marrow transplant by recruiting donors and performing research to improve the patient outcome post transplant.

By filling out the details at the bottom of the page, you are consenting to allow your under 18-year-old child/dependant to join Anthony Nolan register of stem cell donors. We can only accept young adults who are 16 years or older, they will not however become active donors on our Register until their 18th birthday.

To join the Anthony Nolan Register they will need to complete a medical questionnaire, undergo an information session with trained Anthony Nolan staff and have a small saliva sample taken.

If after their 18th birthday, they are found to be a potential life-saving match, they will be contacted for further blood samples that may possibly lead to a donation of stem cells. Before joining the Register they should make sure they fully understand the procedure of donating stem cells. Though donors can remove themselves from the Register at any time up to their 60th birthday we would like this registration to be considered as a serious commitment remaining on the Register.

Please read through the details provided either in the 'BE A MATCH, SAVE A LIFE' information booklet or at www.anthonynolan.org and discuss them with your minor child/dependent before giving signing the 'Parental/Guardian' Consent Form.
